THE SLIDEWIKI PLATFORM ENABLES USERS TO:

1. import, create, and share slides and OER
2. crowdsource and share publicly content
3. manage editing permissions
4. tag and search for content by contacting knowledge communities,
5. create Presentations Rooms where participants can co-create content,
6. semi-automatically translate content in more than 50 languages,
7. use a wide range of interactive tools, including surveys, comment and rate tools to encourage participation of the target audience, embed videos, code and interactive content within your slide, and encourage the audience to experiment.
